

ORDINANCE NO. 109

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE SPEED OF LOCOMOTIVES AND SELF PROPELLED RAILROAD CARS AND THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

[Editor's Note: This ordinance was effectively replaced, though not specifically repealed, by [Ordinance #249](#).]

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any railroad company or its officers, agents or employees to move, propel or operate any locomotive or self-propelled railroad car in a Southbound direction on the line of any railroad track through the Town of Battle Ground, Indiana at a greater rate of speed than forty (40) miles per hour on or across the streets and alleys of the Town.

Section 2. Any officer, agent or employee of a railroad company violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in any sum not exceeding Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for any one offense.
