

ORDINANCE # 11- 491A

Amending Ordinance #321, Section 3, Abandoned Vehicles

Whereas, [Ordinance #321](#), adopted in 1994, defines certain conditions and acts as nuisance violations and provides for the abatement thereof and penalties for violations, and

Whereas, Section 3 of Ordinance #321 contains outdated language to define abandoned vehicles, and

Whereas, Indiana State Code 9-13-2-1 contains updated definitions for abandoned vehicles,

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Battle Ground, Indiana that:

[Section 3](#) of Ordinance #321 be deleted and replaced by the following text:

Section 3: It shall be unlawful for any person other than a licensed automobile, truck or farm implement dealer to keep, park, store or maintain or cause to be kept, parked, stored or maintained on any private or public grounds or property within the corporate limits of the Town of Battle Ground, Indiana, and within public view any abandoned motor vehicle of any and all kinds as set out under Indiana Code 9-13-2-1 or any junk, dismantled, disused or abandoned tractor, implement or farm tool, maintained as above provided is hereby declared a nuisance.

In all other respects, Ordinance #321 shall remain unchanged.
