

# ORDINANCE NO. 249

## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE SPEED OF LOCOMOTIVES AND SELF PROPELLED RAILROAD CARS AND THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

SECTION I It shall be unlawful for any railroad company or its officers, agents or employees to move, propal or operate any locomotive or selfropelled railroad car on the line of any railroad track through th Town of Battle Ground, Indiana at a greater rate of speed than forty (40) miles per hour on or across the streets and alleys of the Town.

SECTION II Any officer, agent or employee of a railroad company violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). No less than nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for any one offense.
