ORDINANCE NO. 249

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE SPEED OF LOCOMOTIVES AND SELF PROPELLED RAILROAD CARS AND THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

<u>SECTION I</u> It shall be unlawful for any railroad company or its officers, agents or employees to move, propal or operate any locomotive or selfropelled railroad — car on the line of any railroad track through th Town of Battle Ground, Indiana at a greater rate of speed than forty (40) miles per hour on or across the streets and alleys of the Town.

<u>SECTION II</u> Any officer, agent or employee of a railroad company violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). No less than nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for any one offense.
