ORDINANCE NO. 292

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PLATTED ALLEY BETWEEN LOTS SIX (6) and SEVEN (7)	IN
TAYLOR'S ADDITION TO BATTLE GROUND CITY, INDIANA	

WHEREAS, there exists a certain three hundred eighty (380) foot long platted alley between lots numbered six (6) and seven (7) in Taylor's Addition to Battle Ground City. Indiana; and

WHEREAS, Town of Battle Ground no longer requires the need for said platted alley; and

WHEREAS, Charles Floyd, the petitioner and adjacent landowner, has complied with all the provisions of the Indiana Code.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BATTLE GROUND, INDIANA, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. The three hundred eighty (380) foot long platted alley between lots numbered six (6) and seven (7) in Taylor's Addition in Battle Ground City, Indiana, is hereby vacated.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective this 1 day of April, 1991.
