

# ORDINANCE NUMBER 301A-92

Editor's Note: This ordinance was effectively replaced, but not specifically repealed, by [Ordinance #07-551](#).

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING TOWN LEGISLATIVE BODIES TO ALLOW THE FISCAL OFFICER TO MAKE CLAIM PAYMENTS IN ADVANCE OF BOARD ALLOWANCE FOR THE FOLLOWING KINDS OF EXPENSES:

- (1) Property or services purchased or leased from the United States Government, its agencies, or its political subdivisions.
- (2) License or permit fees.
- (3) Insurance premiums.
- (4) Utility payments or utility connection charges.
- (5) General grant programs where advance funding is not prohibited and the contracting party posts sufficient security to cover the amount advanced.
- (6) Grants of state funds authorized by statute.
- (7) Maintenance or service agreements.
- (8) Leases or rental agreements.
- (9) Bond or coupon payments.
- (10) Payroll.
- (11) State, federal or county taxes.

WHEREAS, each payment of expenses must be supported by a fully itemized claim and WHEREAS, the town legislative body or Town Board having jurisdiction over the allowance of the claim shall review and allow the claim at its next regular or special meeting following the pre-approved payment of the expense.
